

2014 Mystery Quilt Part I

For this pattern choose 5 fabrics in the same color family graduating the colors from dark to light. The light fabric will be the background. You will also need some black.

Finished quilt size: 76" x96"

Fabric Requirements:

Dark	1 ½ yards
Medium Dark	1 ¼ yards
Medium	1 yard
Medium Light	¾ yard
Light	3 yards
Black	2 yards
Binding fabric (suggest black)	¾ yard
Backing fabric	6 yards

Wash and iron all fabric prior to cutting.

Unit 1 – Four Patch



(18) Light/Black



(18) Medium Light/Black

- Step 1: Cut (2) 2½” strips from the **light** fabric.
 Cut (2) 2½” strips from the **medium light** fabric.
 Cut (4) 2½” strips from the **black** fabric.

- Step 2: Sew (2) strip sets of **light/black**.
 Press seams toward **black**.

- Step 3: Cut (36) 2 ½” units.



- Step 4: Sew (2) strip units together to make a four patch.
 Make (18) Four Patches.



Repeat Steps 2-4 with the **medium light/black** strips to make (18) more Four Patches.
