2014 Quilt Show Entry Form Guidelines
One Entry Form for each submitted item must be received by July 21, 2014

Show Rules for 2014

1. Any active Lick Skillet Quilt Guild (LSQG) member who has paid membership dues on or before July 14, 2014, is eligible to enter. This will be a judged show; however, you may elect to not have your quilt judged.
2. No member may enter more than 6 quilts and/or 1 challenge quilt, for a total of no more than 7 quilts.
3. Only quilts which are clean, undamaged, odor-free, and neatly pieced and quilted may be entered in the show. LSQG leadership reserves the right to refuse entry of any quilt not meeting stated requirements.
4. Each quilt to be judged must have been pieced by the LSQG member within the last ten years.
5. A 4" sleeve must be sewn onto the back. Sleeves are not needed on small quilts or wall hangings which are 36" or less in width (across the top).
6. Entries must have 3 layers: fabric top, batting, and backing, except yoyo's and cathedral window quilts. No framed pieces are eligible.
7. Each quilt must be identified with a label, including owner's name and name of quilt, sewn or fused to the back of quilt.
8. If a quilt hangs onto the floor, it will be pinned or folded at the bottom.
9. No purchased quilts are eligible; however, purchased kits and/or Block of the Month quilts will be eligible.
10. A 4" x 6" photo must be stapled to the registration form. On the back of the photo include member's name, title of the quilt, an arrow indicating top of quilt and the dimensions (width by length). Photos are for layout, identification and publicity purposes. They should be clear, show good color, and fill the frame of the picture. Photos will not be returned.
11. The goal is to hang all quilts; however, LSQG leadership reserves the right to not hang every quilt and not award all ribbons. On the registration form, please number your entries in order of preference (1 being your first choice to be hung, 2 next choice, 3 next choice, etc.)
12. Any quilt entered can be submitted for exhibition only. If you desire to submit a quilt along with its awarded ribbon or special recognition from a previous judged show, you are encouraged to do so. However, any quilts submitted for exhibition will not be eligible for judging. Only quilts entered to be judged in this show will be eligible for awards. Please indicate on the entry form whether you desire for your quilt to be judged or entered as exhibition only.
13. Design source or inspiration must be included on the form. (Let's give credit where it is due!)
14. LSQG leadership reserves the right to change categories of entries but will attempt to contact the owner before making any changes.
15. The Best of Show quilt is not eligible for any other award or ribbon.
16. Deadline for entry forms is Monday, July 21, 2014; however, you are encouraged to turn in your forms as early as possible.
17. Quilts are to be turned in on Tuesday, September 2nd. The location for turning in quilts will be announced at a later date. Judging will be Thursday, September 4th.
18. Each quilt entered must be submitted in a plastic bag. Please fold the quilt so that label with owner's name and name of quilt can be seen clearly through the bag.
19. Quilts must be picked up on Saturday, September 13, after 4:30 P.M. at the Oxford Civic Center. The owner of each quilt must either pick up quilt(s) herself/himself or give written permission and receipt to the person responsible for picking up quilt(s).
