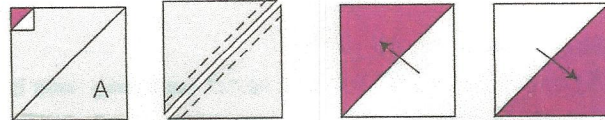


Mystery Quilt 2015 *Part 2*
Piecing the Blocks – Block W

Note: press all seam allowances in the direction of the arrows in the figures.

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the **white/cream A squares**. Lay one over a **third dark A**, right sides together. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Each pair of the squares makes 2 half-squares triangle (HST) units.

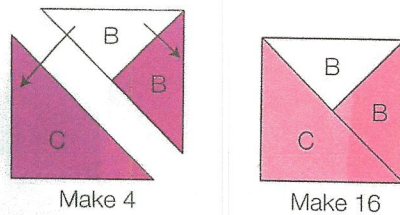


Making the HST units

Repeat to make a total of:

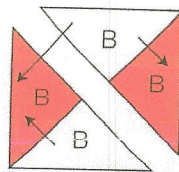
- 16 third dark/white/cream HST units
- 56 First ark/white/cream HST units
- 80 bright color/white/cream HST units
- 32 darker bright color/white/cream HST units

Step 2: Referring to the diagram, join a **white/cream B triangle** and a **third dark B triangle** on the short sides. Add a **third dark C triangle**. Make 4 **third dark half-hourglass units**. Repeat with the **white/cream B**, **second dark B**, and **second dark C triangles** to make 16 **second dark half-hourglass units**.



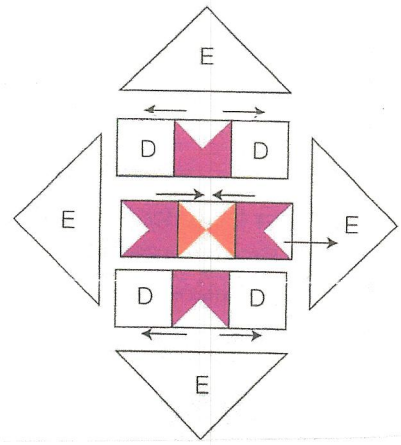
Half-hourglass units

Step 3: Join a white/cream and a **bright B triangle** on the short sides. Make 2. Join the triangle units. Make 1 QST unit.



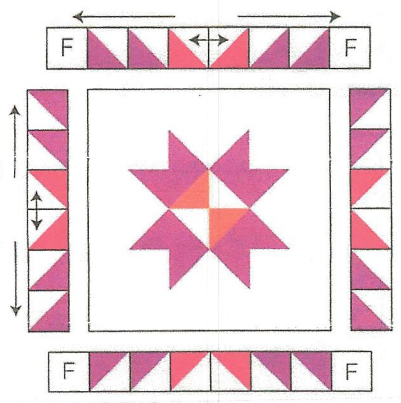
QST Unit – make 1

Step 4: for Block W center, lay out 4 **third dark half-hourglass units**, 4 **white/cream D squares**, and the **bright color QST unit**. Sew into rows. Sew the rows together. Sew **white/cream E triangles** to the sides, then to the top and bottom of the center unit.

Step 5: Join 4 **third dark** and 2 **first dark HST units** to make a block border unit. Make 4. Sew to the sides of the center unit. Add **white/cream F squares** to each end of the remaining border units and sew to the top and bottom of the block center to complete Block W. Make 1.
